

Lesson 14 – Matthew 17:24-20:34

Day 1: Matthew 17:24-18:20

What do you think Jesus means when he says you must become like children to enter the kingdom of heaven?

Think about how Jesus talks about sin in our passage, how does this compare to your response to sin?

Day 2: Matthew 18:21-35

Jesus has some hard things to say about forgiveness in this passage (example: if you don't forgive others, neither will you be forgiven), do you think Jesus is being unrealistic is how he expects his followers to forgive.

What are some things that have been hard for you to forgive in your own life?

Day 3: Matthew 19

Why do you think the rich young ruler left sorrowful when Jesus told him to sell all his possessions?

Is there anything that Jesus has called you to do that do you do not want to obey him in?

Day 4: Matthew 20:1-19

If you had been a disciple, learning with Jesus all this time, what would your response be to Jesus telling you that he is going to die?

Day 5: Matthew 20:20-34

What do you think it means to be great?

Do you agree with what Jesus says that to be great you must be a servant? Why or why not?
