FURTHER STUDY

- 1. As the New Year begins what are some changes that you would like to make in your everyday life?
 - ⇒ Have you attempted to make those same changes in the past?
 - \Rightarrow If so, what were the results?
- 2. How do you handle changes in life that you feel are out of your control?
 - ⇒ What does it take for you to adapt to "the new normal" when changes occur that are not in your control to make?
- 3. This week we heard that God's promises are what give us hope and vision to take the next steps in the new opportunities and challenges God offers us. We also heard that God's promises come with conditions. As you read John 14, what promises and conditions does Jesus offer to the disciples prior to his crucifixion (and the challenges he knew they would encounter)?
- 4. "Fearless Faith" means we take Scripture seriously and desire to live out God's commands. How does Hebrews 4:12-13 reinforce the power of God's Word and the importance of doing what it says?
 - ⇒ Can you think of any times in the past weeks, months or years that God's Word has had the kind of power in your live that is described in the Hebrews passage you read above?
 - ⇒ How are you doing at putting into action what you learn from God's Word?
- 5. Obeying what God calls us to can be frightening and may not even seem worth the pain or challenge. How does James 1:2-4, 12 help you to continue to obey and move forward when it seems like God may not be coming through on His end in the midst of a challenge or trial?
