## **FURTHER STUDY**

- 1. The Trinity family is seeking to Experience God's Purpose Together. This simply means that we are seeking God to know what He desires to do through us for His glory.
  - $\Rightarrow$  Who does He want us to reach with the gospel and how does He want us to reach them?
  - $\Rightarrow$  Pray with us that we will see many Connect to Christ and one another, be **B**uilt up in the Word of God and **R**eleased to serve His purpose.
- 2. For the Trinity family to fulfill God's call for His church it will mean a sacrifice on the part of every family in our congregation. Our generosity usually flows from the perspective of our possessions.
  - $\Rightarrow$  How might a person balance saving, retirement and the attitude of the man in the parable found in Luke?
  - $\Rightarrow$  Read Luke 12:13-21
  - $\Rightarrow$  What are one or two decisions this man could have made that would have demonstrated a wiser outlook?
