 - ⇒ Why did Jesus give us this example of what it means to be a servant?
 - ⇒ What clues to the motive of this act of service do we see in verse 1?
 - ⇒ What do you suppose was the response of the disciples?
 - ⇒ What was Peter's response?
 - ⇒ What would your response to this act of humility be?
 - ⇒ Read Verses 12-17 and discuss the essence of what Jesus was displaying for them and why it is so significant that we understand His command to us as a church family and as individual followers.
3. When was the last time that you can recall doing something simply for one of the reasons stated in the sermon? (The strong are to serve the weak; prefer others above yourself; give God the glory.)
4. How do we live out what Jesus taught in Matthew 5:13-16?
 - ⇒ What is the meaning of "salt and light" in this well known passage?
5. As followers of Jesus, we are counted on to do something with what we know. How can we continue to "live out" the following passages and remain effective as a church in our communities?
