Sunday School

Sunday mornings we teach students practical skills to help them live out their faith in the everyday stuff of life. This year we will focus on three skills over the year:

- Studying the Bible
- Prayer
- Sharing the Gospel with others.

Closer Curriculum

- The curriculum using is called CLOSER.
 - The goal is to help students understand what it means to be a disciple and what kind of life it creates.
 - This is complimentary to what we are looking to achieve on Sunday Nights
- Sunday nights is learning and growing together in community
- Sunday mornings is learning the skills to grow together in community.

Mid-Week Connection

There are two options for mid-week connection.

- Awana Help the children with the various activities in Awana
- Informal Hangout
 - Student are looking for opportunities to connect with their friends during the middle of the week.
 - We have told them that they are free to connect with their small group outside Sunday Nights
 - Open up your home to the possibility of your teen inviting their friends over.
 - Gives you opportunity to be involved in the discipleship process and know what is going on in their friendships.

- Offer to do these things with them.
