

Lesson 17 – Matthew 26-28:20

Day 1: Matthew 26:1-16

Do you agree more with the disciples or Jesus' reaction to the woman anointing Jesus' with oil? Why?

Day 2: Matthew 26:17-75

Think about how Jesus prays in this passage. What does that show you about prayer?

Describe a time when you have been like Peter, where you commit to doing something for God and then don't follow through? What is your response after you fail to do what you committed to do?

Day 3: Matthew 27:1-56

As you read through the events leading up to Jesus' death, what are your reactions?

Remember that Pilate did not think Jesus was guilty, but he still sentenced him to execution to please the crowd. Have you ever done anything you knew was wrong to please the people around you?

Day 4: Matthew 27:57-28:15

Do you believe that Jesus rose from the dead as it is described in this passage? Why or why not?

Why do you think it was so important to Pilate and the Jews to make sure people didn't know Jesus rose from the dead?

Day 5: Matthew 28:16-20

In what ways are you currently obey or disobeying the last commands of Jesus to his disciples?

What is a specific way you could obey his commands this week?
