- Persevering together (Philippians 1:29; James 1:2-4; Romans 5:3-5)
- Perpetually die to self (Philippians 2:3-4, 7-8; Luke 9:23; John 12:24; 2 Corinthians 4:8-12)
- Power from the Spirit in you (Philippians 4:13; Romans 8:11; Galatians 5:22-25)
