## From Fallen to Family 1 Peter 2:4-10

- Only through the Rock do we find our role. (1 Peter 2:4)
- Christianity is a communal faith. (1 Peter 2:5)
- Our destiny is tied to the family stone. (1 Peter 2:6-8)
- We are set apart by God to show and share Him with the world. (1 Peter 2:9-10)

**Memory Verse:** “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.” - 1 Peter 2:9-10 (ESV)
