***Eve, Mother of All Living***  
***Genesis 1:26-31; 2:7, 3***

Creation:

- How does this woman uniquely reflect the image of God?
- Image – statue, expression, representation, role in place
- God created humanity to represent Him to the world.
- God endowed man with His image so man can reflect God's image into the world.
- Humanity is made in God's likeness to clearly distinguish God from humans.
- Men and women are created in the image of God.
- Neither men on their own nor women on their own can fulfill this calling to fill the earth.
- As God's representatives, humans are entrusted to fill, rule, and govern the earth.
- God crowns humanity with glory and honor to rule over the works of his hands.
- Woman along with man is to reflect the image of God into the world. Together they represent God.

Redemption:

- How does God pursue her?
- How does God demonstrate His love for her in how He called her?
- The woman's offspring will bruise the head of the serpent and the serpent will bruise the heel of the woman's offspring.

Calling:

- How does God use this woman as a key component in the greater redemption narrative?
- Eve points us to a living hope.
- The offspring of Eve has made a way for us to be brought back to glory.
- God's intention through Eve's offspring is to allow us to live out the calling to reflect the image of God into this world.

**BIG Idea:** God's plan all along is for us to inherit the world that God gave to Adam and Eve to reflect his image.

**Memory Verse:** “So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.” – Genesis 1:27 (ESV)

**Other Scripture:** Psalm 8; Romans 4:13
