



The Shepherd Restores My Soul Psalm 23:2-3a

The shepherd makes, leads, and restores.

The shepherd leads us to restoration.

Sheep depend on the shepherd to find pasture and water.

The Lord is the shepherd of His people.

Big Idea: Jesus restores our souls when we rest and trust in Him.

I lack nothing.

I don't need a thing.

I will not be in need.

When you rest in Jesus, you will lack nothing.

Memory Verse: "He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul." - Psalm 23:2-3a (ESV)

Other Scripture: Ezekiel 34:14-16; Revelation 7:17, 22:17

Further Study:

Read: Psalm 23 in your group or with at least one other person.

1. Have someone read it while everyone reads along.
2. Have someone else read it while everyone else listens.
3. Have someone recount the text from memory in their own words.
