## Psalm 114

First scene: God's deliverance of Israel from Egypt (Exodus 14)

Second scene: Crossing the Jordan River into the Promised Land (Joshua 3)

Third scene: God appearing to His people on Mt Sinai (Exodus 19:1-20)

Fourth scene: Water from the rock (Exodus 17:1-7)

### Further Study:

### Discuss:

1. What does the passage reveal about God?
2. What does the passage reveal about humanity?

### Act:

1. If this passage is from God, what should change about how you live?
2. Who needs to hear the truth of this Scripture that you can share it with this week? Identify a time this week when you might have the opportunity to share with them.
