2 Corinthians 8:8-15; Exodus 16

Biblical generosity is the joy-filled, grace-based, act of loving obedience in response to God's gospel generosity through Christ.

Lessons from manna about money:

- Both are gifts from God.
- Hoarding has the potential to harm you.
- Trust God for your daily provision.
- Do you have an abundance of resources that you can use to bless others?
