

GospelInformed Conduct Galatians 2:11-14

In what ways was Peter's conduct out of step with the truth of the gospel?

- His actions directly contradicted the Word of God.
- His actions were based on fear of man, not fear of God.
- His actions nullified the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

Why did Paul confront Peter publicly concerning his conduct?

- Peter's public sin required a public response.
- Paul used this rebuke to teach an important gospel lesson.
