

The Law of Christ Galatians 6:1-5

Reviewing the purpose of the law of Moses

- The Old Testament declares that we are all sinners and not able to obey God.
- The Old Testament points clearly to Jesus, the Messiah, as the solution.

The "Law of Christ" is established at the cross, where Christ died for us sinners. This act of love completely changes our relationship with God and others, and now His Spirit frees us to love like He loves.

Romans 3:10-18; Galatians 3:22-26, 4:6, 5:19-23; Ezekiel 11:19-20, 36:26-27; Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 5:21-48, 18:23-35, 22:34-40; John 15:12; 1 John 3:16, 4:10-11, 21
