Pastor Jason spoke about the impetus and vision of the [Freeing Tomorrow campaign](#) and discussed the goals the elders had in mind when they listened to the congregation and gave the green light for the campaign. The main goal, as you have heard, was to eliminate Trinity's \$2 million debt and free us from the interest payments which will increase in the near future, further hampering our ministry impact.

A leadership contingent had made pledges prior to October 30, which are spread over the next three years. These advance commitments totaled over \$1.5 million and this was joyfully announced! Then the entire congregation was invited to join in the campaign and complete the work through their participation. Informational brochures were given to all in attendance and Pastor Jason urged them to pray, asking God to lead in their generosity toward Freeing Tomorrow.

Our elders and staff are humbly seeking Godly discernment on specific ministries to institute or enlarge as the \$21,495 per month currently going to mortgage payments is transformed into an asset for gospel growth.
