

The King Shall Return Revelation 19:11 – 20:15

The story of Christmas is the story of God: 7000 years and counting.

God has documented His faithfulness for the last 6000 years. We can trust Him for the next 1000+.

The story of Christmas leads to one of two eternal outcomes for humanity: with God or the lake of fire.

We all need to be reminded of the truth of God:

- God is awesome in a terrifying way and no person will escape His judgment! (Hebrews 10:31)
- Salvation is through grace alone. (Ephesians 2:8-9)
- No person is beyond God's grace. (Romans 10:11-13)
- The redeemed are called to love others (Matthew 22:39), share the Gospel (Matthew 28:19), and to be ambassadors for Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:20)
