"Sin is any lack of conformity to God's will in attitude, thought, or action, whether committed actively or passively. The center of all sin is autonomy, which is the replacing of God with self. Always closely associated with sin are its products – pride, selfishness, idolatry, and lack of peace (shalom)." - John MacArthur and Richard Mayhue, Biblical Doctrine: A Systematic Summary of Bible Truth
