Our Men's Ministry and Women's Ministry draw on God's wisdom expressed in the two genders. These ministries include a focus on our unique roles as wives and husbands, fathers and mothers, daughters and sons, and brothers and sisters.

Our Deep Discipleship classes will bring college-level biblical learning into the local church. Our desire is to help the people of Trinity grow in their knowledge of God and equip them for greater service in God's kingdom.
